
The recycling journey of paper-based Tetra Pak® cartons





You can give carton packages a new life Start recycling in 3 simple steps:

- Fully empty your beverage carton
- Flatten the package
- Place the whole package, including the cap, in the correct recycling bin










Collection and sorting

Once collected, the cartons are separated from other packaging and sent on to the paper mills.








At the paper mills


The cartons are loaded in a pulper and blended with water. This separates the paper from the polymers and aluminium.






Recycling of paper fibres

The paper fibres are cleaned, pressed, dried, and then formed into paper rolls.




Recycling of polymers & aluminium

In some places, polymers and aluminum are used to produce energy. Where the infrastructure allows, the polymers and aluminum (PolyAl) are extracted and shredded together, and then turned into granules.
